

**2020 Sheep Online Junior Judging Competition
TERMS AND CONDITIONS****1. USER AGREEMENT**

By entering the competition, you are deemed to have read and understood these Terms & Conditions and to have agreed to be bound by them.

2. ENTRANTS ELIGIBILITY

By entering, you accept these Terms and warrant that you are:

- (a) entering the competition once only per class (Cleanskin, Short wool or Long wool)
- (b) Understanding that participants can enter each class, but are only guaranteed to have their first preference judged
- (c) providing a valid email address (and phone number if requested).
- (d) agreeing to receive news and updates from the Royal Melbourne Show

3. UNAUTHORISED USE OF THE COMPETITION

An entrant must be an individual and not a company or organisation. Employees of the Promoter and any person associated with the Competition, and any organisation or individual associated with the provision of the prize(s), are not eligible to enter

4. PRIZE VALUE

5. LENGTH OF THE COMPETITION

The promotion will run on the Royal Melbourne Show website between 12pm Thursday 3 September and 11:59pm Wednesday 16 September 2020.

6. THE ENTRY PROCESS

By entering the Competition, each entrant agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. The Promoter may in its discretion refuse to award any prize to any entrant who fails to comply with these Terms and Conditions. All relevant instructions to enter the Competition form part of these Terms and Conditions.

To enter this competition, participants can submit up to one video per class, and must nominate their preferred submission to be judged. Participants are able to, but it is not necessary to enter all classes. Entries can be in either an .mp4, mp3 or .mov format. Participants must judge all three sheep in the chosen class category. Video submissions must be sent via a Dropbox or WeTransfer link to sheep@rasv.com.au. Email must include:

- Email including:
 - First name and Last name
 - School name or associated Stud name
 - Date of birth
 - Phone number
 - Name of video chosen to submit judging comments

Entrants can choose to submit up to one entry per video class and must nominate their preferred submission to be judged. Judges do not guarantee more than one submission per entrant will be judged.

Entries can be in either video or audio format, and must not exceed 3 ½ minutes in length

Files must be in either an .mp4, .mp3 or .mov format

Entries must judge all three sheep in the category

Entrants will be automatically categorised by their DOB into one of the following competition classes:

- Under 12
- Ages 12-15
- Ages 16-19

Submissions must be a continuous audio or visual stream. Minimal edits for shortening pauses or removing irrelevant content will be allowed. Points will be deducted where further editing is evident.

The content must be provided by the single youth or student submitting the entry. Points will be deducted where coaching or assistance off-camera is evident.

The judging panel may contact and ask additional questions of entrants where it is too difficult to decide the winner on the submission alone. The judges' decision will be final.

Entry into the Competition is free. The winners will be judged by The Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria Sheep Committee Judges. One prize winner from each age group will be selected.

The winners of the prize winner will be published on the Royal Melbourne Show website, Royal Melbourne Show Facebook and Royal Melbourne Show Instagram on Tuesday 22 September.
